Some Comments from Kauri on the Duathlon

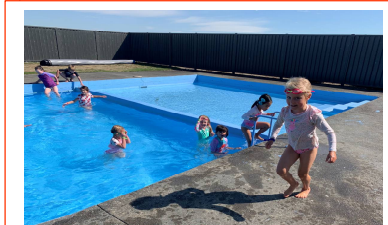
Dyrfinna -The swimming made me happy.
