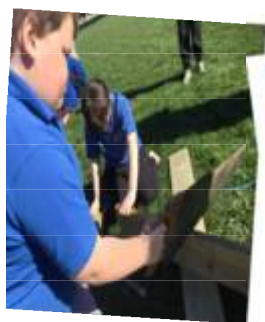
News from Wakanui
