A Factorial is when we

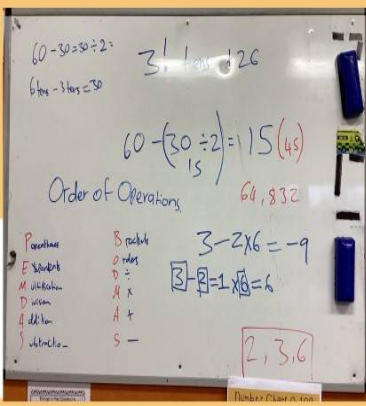
times the number by everything below it, example $(6 \times 5 \times 4 \times 3 \times 2 \times 1)$

A Power of is when you get a number and times it by whatever number you can use

K Example (6 to the power of 3. The 3 should go on top of the 6)

A $6 \times 6 \times 6 = 216$

We only had the numbers 2,3,6 to use to get numbers on the chart. For example if you did $(26 \times 3) = 78$. So we could only use those numbers for the chart and if we got a number we crossed it off in red marker.
